

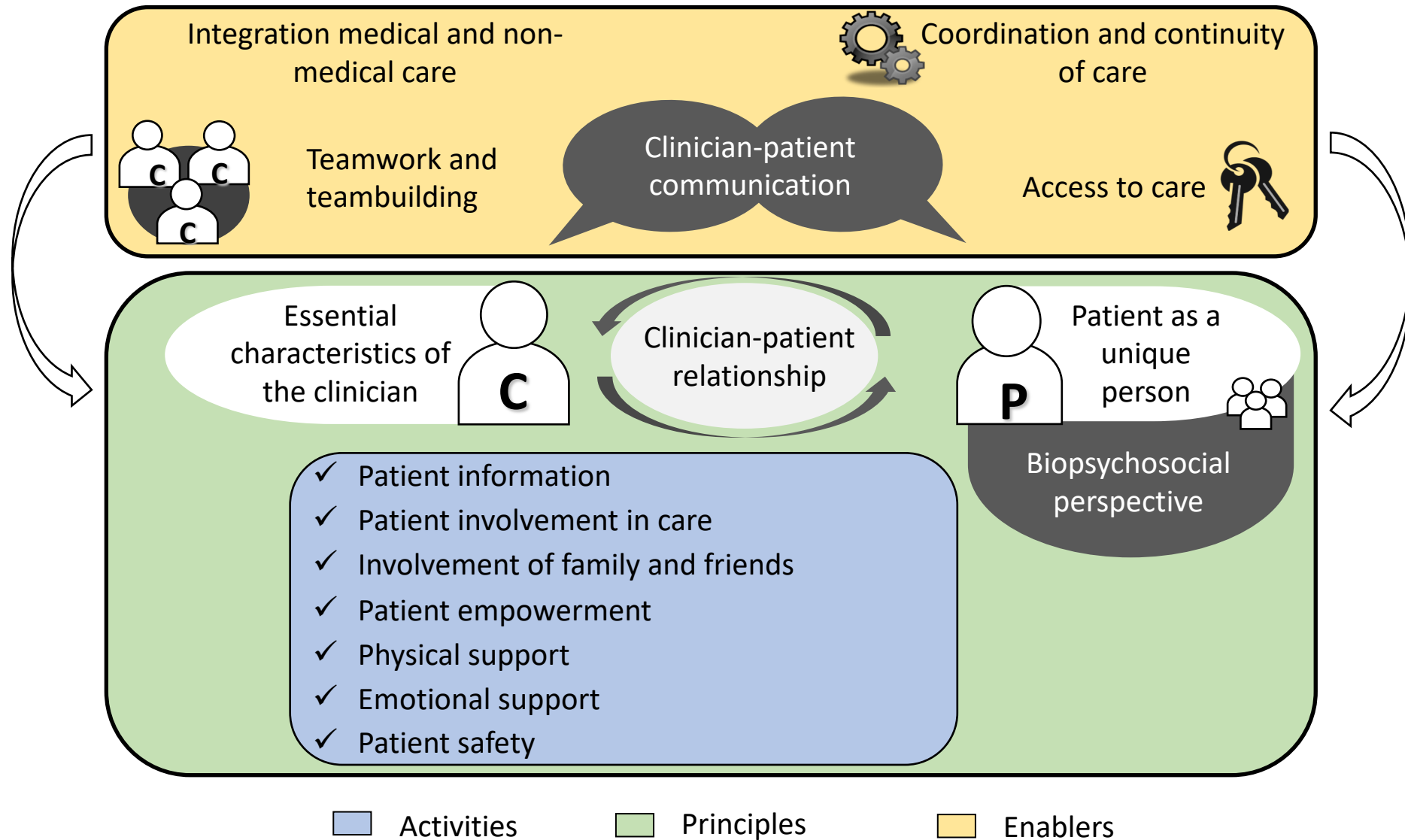
Integrative model of patient-centeredness
